


You Need for Chiropractic Billing

CPT modifiers are two-character alphanumeric codes that provide additional information about a Current Procedural Terminology (CPT) code

Why Modifiers Matter:

- Prevent claim rejections
- Ensure correct reimbursement
- Clarify unique aspects of chiropractic services
- Help avoid audits

Top 5 Chiropractic Modifiers




Best Tips for Using Modifiers

Know When to Use Each Modifier

Use the correct modifier for each situation. For example,

Modifier 25 is specifically for E/M services, while Modifier 59 is used for distinct, separate procedures.
